Dr. Mallenbaum has more than 30 years of experience practicing neurology. He comes to Sacred Heart from serving as medical director of the Primary Stroke Center at Carilion Medical Center and an associate professor of neurology at Virginia Tech Carilion School of Medicine. Dr. Mallenbaum was also a graduate of the Carilion Clinic Physician Leadership Academy.

He is triple board-certified in neurology, electrodiagnostic medicine and neuroimaging. Dr. Mallenbaum is a fellow of the American Association of Neuromuscular and Electrodiagnostic Medicine and of the American Heart Association Stroke Council. His research has been published in several peer-reviewed medical journals, including "New England Journal of Medicine," "Journal of the American Medical Association," "Acute Medicine" and "Stroke." He has served as principal investigator in 25 clinical trials, and he has been awarded more than \$480,000 worth of grants to study stroke treatment and prevention.

Dr. Mallenbaum graduated with his bachelor's degree in psychology from McGill University in Montreal, Canada, where he was named a University Scholar and a Faculty Scholar. He received his medical degree from the University of North Carolina School of Medicine at Chapel Hill. He performed an internship in internal medicine at Royal Victoria Hospital in Montreal, Canada, and he completed a residency in neurology through McGill University Health Centre's Montreal Neurological Institute, where he served as chief resident.
