Legendary Rock and Roller, Ace Frehley to Perform at the Saenger Theatre Former Lead Guitarist for KISS – Currently Touring Solo

Ace's work as lead guitarist and as a songwriter for KISS helped turn the band into one of rock's hottest phenomena, with a string of hit albums and sold-out shows rarely matched in rock history. His acclaimed, smash hit 1978 self-titled solo album demonstrated that he could comfortably stand in the spotlight alone, and his long, distinguished and slightly idiosyncratic post-KISS career has proven that to be true.
