## **NAS PENSACOLA ANNUAL TREE-PLANTING CEREMONY**

PENSACOLA, Fla. --- The Naval Air Station Pensacola (NASP) Public Works Department (PWD) is scheduled to host its annual Arbor Day Foundation Tree City USA tree-planting ceremony Dec. 7, at 1 p.m. at the corner of Radford Blvd. and Duncan Road onboard NAS Pensacola.

NAS Pensacola Commanding Officer Capt. Christopher Martin is scheduled to attend the event.

This marks the 24th year the air station has participated in the Arbor Day Foundation's Tree City USA program.

More than 3,400 communities across the nation have made the commitment to becoming a Tree City USA by meeting four core standards of sound urban forestry management: maintaining a tree board department, have a community tree ordinance, spending at least \$2 per capita on urban forestry, and by recognizing Arbor Day each year.
