Magazine names Pensacola as top place to relocate for retirees

Where to Retire will feature Pensacola on its cover and be profiled in its July/August 2018 issue. The magazine will be available on newsstands June 12.

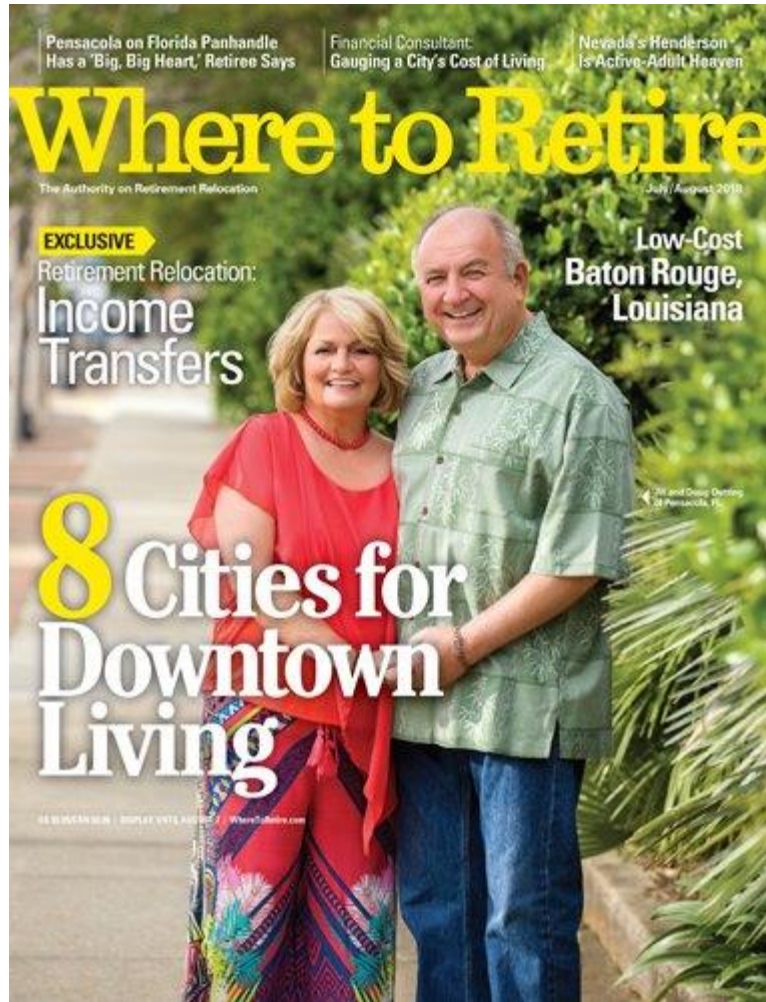
Annette Fuller, the magazine's editor, chose to highlight Pensacola because she said it has important qualities for today's retirees.
