Sacred Heart to Provide Free Health Screenings in July

During July, Sacred Heart Health System will provide free heart-health and osteoporosis screenings at locations in Pensacola, Cantonment and Milton for adults who are poor, elderly or uninsured.

Heart-health screenings will measure blood pressure, blood sugar and total cholesterol, and can detect anemia. The screenings are helpful in diagnosing conditions that put people at high risk for heart attack, stroke, diabetes and other health problems. Osteoporosis screenings measure bone density.

Following is the schedule for July:

- July 10, from 8:30 to 11 a.m. at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, 6451 Park Ave., Milton. Osteoporosis screenings only.
- July 17 from 9 to 11:30 a.m. at Faith Epicenter Church of God, 9910 Guidy Lane, Pensacola. Heart-health screenings only.
- July 18 from 9 to 11:30 a.m. at Marie Young Community Center, 6405 Wagner St., Pensacola. Osteoporosis screenings only.
- July 25 from 9 to 11:30 a.m. at Health & Hope Clinic, 1718 E. Olive Rd., Pensacola. Heart-health screenings only.
- July 26 from 9 to 11:30 a.m. at Victory Assembly of God, 1895 Victory Rd., Cantonment. Osteoporosis screenings only.
- July 28 from 9 to 11 a.m. at Greater Mount Pleasant AME Church, 711 Calloway St., Cantonment. Heart-health screenings only.
