Her paintings, a reflection of her life and earth's gifts, provide alluring images and healing for all. Margaret has participated in numerous art festivals, has won several awards and has had multiple solo shows, including a museum exhibition titled "Visions; Through Paintings and Poetry." Her paintings now hang in medical facilities, hospitals, doctor's offices, hotels and

numerous private homes from coast to coast. Because of her various subject matter, reference to coastal areas, contemporary design and the abstract quality of her holistic pieces, Biggs has the vision and ability to create paintings that would enhance most locations. The dynamic use of color, shape and line coalesce in such a way as to create strong, peaceful imagery, known to have a healing effect on the viewer.
