## **Registration Deadline Approaching for the Pensacola Children's Chorus 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Summer Festival**

The Pensacola Children's Chorus will host its 2nd Annual Summer Festival Monday, July 23 through Friday, July 27, 2018. Young performers interested in having fun while developing vocal skills will spend an exciting week at the Pensacola Children's Chorus.

Singers will participate in dynamic music classes while they explore performance skills in age-appropriate vocal artistry, engaging and game-based sight singing, creative and hands-on music theory, world music exploration, and movement based on music and musicianship.

Registration is \$185 per student and open to grades third through eighth. Festival hours are 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday – Friday and will be located at the PCC offices (46 E. Chase Street, Pensacola, FL 32502). Deadline to register students is Wednesday, July 11.

“This experience is a one-of-a-kind musical opportunity,” says Alex Gartner, Artistic Director. “The camp is a real combination of learning and fun—and very rarely do the kids realize they’re learning! It’s toward the end of the summer when everyone is getting the back-to-school jitters. This is a great way to get back into the swing of things and get immersed in the environment of the Pensacola Children's Chorus.”

As part of the Summer Festival, participants have the opportunity to sing for friends, family, and community members at two performances Saturday, July 28. The first performance will be located at First Presbyterian Church in downtown Pensacola (33 E Gregory St, Pensacola, FL 32502). The second performance will be singing the national anthem during opening ceremonies at the Pensacola Blue Wahoo's game that evening. Tickets for each can be purchased in advance through the Pensacola Children's Chorus.
