Surgeons Join Sacred Heart Medical Parks at Perdido and Tiger Point

The two new 28,000 square-foot medical parks offer primary care and specialist doctors in cardiology, orthopedics and gynecology, with appointments for endocrinology and obstetrics offered at the Tiger Point location. Both medical parks also include:

- Adult outpatient rehabilitation, including physical, occupational and speech therapy
- Laboratory services
- Advanced diagnostic imaging, including mammography, CT, X-ray, MRI, ultrasound and DEXA
