STATE REPRESENTATIVE TO HOST FARMSHARE ON JANUARY 12, 2019

Escambia County, Fla. — Newly elected State Representative Alex Andrade will partner with Brownsville Assembly of God to host a Farmshare on January 12, 2019 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Farmshare is a nationally recognized organization that provides fresh produce at no charge to individuals and families facing hunger. A large bag of produce and food products are distributed one per family on a first come, first serve basis.

“Making sure our friends and neighbors are fed during this time of year is a critical need, and bouncing back from the Christmas season can be tough for people who work hard just to get by. Any relief we can provide for individuals and families is a step in the right direction,” said Andrade.

Over 100 community volunteers will work alongside Representative Andrade and Brownsville to distribute the food. There will be two ways for Escambia County citizens to pick up the bags of food; through either a drive-up lane or a walk-up line.

“Thank you to Brownsville Assembly of God for your willingness to host this incredible program,” said Andrade.
