Leadership Pensacola Class 2019 is leveraging its capacity to accomplish a greater good in Pensacola. The class has formed three teams to serve and engage a project identified by three of our local nonprofits. Big Brothers Big Sisters of Northwest Florida's mission is to provide children facing adversity with strong and enduring, professionally supported one-to-one relationships that change their lives for the better, forever. They help children realize their potential and build their futures.

Team Leap Start's main goal is to implement a Post Secondary Readiness Roadmap for "Bigs" to help guide their "Littles" in preparation for their future after high school – whether that future involves continuing education, career, trade school, or the military. The roadmap will offer resources and information by grade level starting in the 9th grade. Additionally, Team Leap Start will be creating and providing the initial startup funds necessary for the first ever Big Brothers Big Sisters of Northwest Florida Scholarship Program.

The mission of Gulf Coast Kids House is to facilitate the investigation, prosecution and treatment of child abuse and neglect and promote child abuse prevention awareness through community education.

1 in 11 children in Escambia County are affected by an allegation of child abuse, and education about recognizing the signs and how to report child abuse is key to its elimination. Project Tipping Point's main goal is to develop an easily consumable, web-based training program to educate the general public on how to identify, report and prevent child abuse. The initial objective of this program is to reach 10% of the population of Escambia County over the next 12 months with the ultimate goal of reaching all citizens age 18 or older. Your contribution will support the development, promotion and ongoing sustainability of the training program, and ultimately will reduce the incidence of child abuse in our community.



Manna is dedicated to fighting hunger in Escambia & Santa Rosa Counties. Manna offers emergency food assistance, services the food-related needs of vulnerable populations, and engages the community in the fight against hunger.

Team Moving Manna's mission is to improve and beautify Manna's new warehouse facility by adding a utility storage building on property, replacing the perimeter fence around the property, and adding landscaping to the building façade. In doing so, we hope to provide Manna with the resources to provide a welcoming environment to neighbors in need and volunteers while allowing Manna to focus on its mission of fighting hunger in the local community.
