Sacred Heart to Provide Free Health Screenings in April

During April, Sacred Heart Health System will provide free heart-health screenings at locations in Pensacola, Milton and Beulah for adults who are poor, elderly or uninsured. Heart-health screenings will measure blood pressure, blood sugar and total cholesterol, and can detect anemia. The screenings are helpful in diagnosing conditions that put people at high risk for heart attack, stroke, diabetes and other health problems.
