Pensacola, Fla. (November 14, 2018) – In November, Lakeview Center CEO Allison Hill was welcomed by The Florida Network of Youth and Family Services Board of Directors to serve as a new member. In 2014 she was promoted to chief operating officer and she became Lakeview’s third chief executive officer in 2016. Hill now leads the daily functions of a \$295 million, 3,000-employee organization that impacts lives in 14 states and the District of Columbia.
