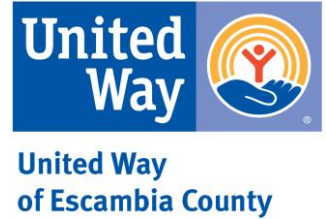

United Way of Escambia County’s agency certification process opens on Monday, November 5. To be eligible to apply, agencies must be a 501 (c) 3 non-profit in good standing, and provide health and human services in Escambia County.

Agencies that are approved as certified partners may apply for funding when the organization’s grant process opens in January.
